

# CITY OF GLENWOOD SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

## JULY 9, 2020 - 11:30 AM

### MINUTES

The City Council of Glenwood Arkansas met in special session with one agenda item. the proposed ordinance 2020-04, an ordinance proposed by the Arkansas municipal League and endorsed by the governor of the state to express the encouragement of the city for all citizens to wear masks in public.

The meeting was called to order at 11:35 by Mayor Smith with all (4) councilmen present. After a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance the mayor asked for someone to introduce ordinance 2020-04. Councilwoman Baker moved to introduce and that was seconded by Powell, Baker and Powell also moved to read the ordinance. All votes were unanimous.

The council took up discussion of the ordinance, also the council heard from citizen Johnny Plyler who expressed his opposition to the ordinance.

The council affirmed unanimously to table the ordinance. (19:37-20:15 minutes)

Next the Council voted unanimously to approve a motion by Clark with a second by Powell: to amend the agenda and include a discussion of police vehicles.

After discussion, the council voted unanimously on a motion by Baker and a second by Powell to purchase two police vehicles from Red River Dodge. A 2020 Durango for \$28,882.00 and a Ram Pickup for \$25,680.00.

The council acknowledged contributions to the Police Department of \$2300.00 from citizens living in the Tranquil Lane Sub-Division of another \$500 was acknowledged as being received from the South Hot Springs Lions Club and presented by Terry and Kathy Hudson.

Charlie Caldwell moved to adjourn with a second from Karen Baker the vote was unanimous.


