

ORDINANCE NO. 10-04

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A CHARGE FOR DAMAGES  
TO WATER METERS AND MXU'S

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GLENWOOD, ARKANSAS:


SECTION 1: The customer shall be responsible for the meter and equipment that is on their property and shall be responsible for any damage thereto and will maintain a 3-foot minimum area around the meter box, clear of all obstructions. In the event of any need for repair or replacement of the meter and equipment as a result of the customer's actions, creating damage to meter and equipment, the cost shall be at the customer's expense.

SECTION 11: The City shall determine the damage cost and the maintenance cost to repair such meter and equipment and the fee will be added to the customer's water bill.

SECTION 111: Any person found guilty of a violation of this Ordinance shall upon conviction, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).


